Odd couple nets upset of City Tourney's second seeds

Women's doubles action heated up Sunday, literally, and offered some surprises to onlookers and players in the Ann Arbor City Tennis Tournament.

Foremost was the upset of second seeds Julie Burdelski and Lauren Watassek in the women's A division.

There, the veteran-new comer pair of Charlene Vanvick and Mena Lolucci wowed more than two dozen spectators with a 6-7 (7-4), 6-0, 6-4 victory.

Easily the most watched, the match forced oohs, ahhs and applause from spectators who were treated to tit-for-tat play for almost two hours.

But the combination of Vanvick's consistent returns and Lolucci's aggressive net play proved to be too much for the newly formed Burdelski-Watassek combo.

"They had good reflexes and volleys," said Burdelski, who plays at Miami University in Ohio. "They had some gets, some surprises that we weren't expecting."

Watassek, who plays for Eastern Michigan University, agreed, but added a touch of upbeat.

"This is the first time we've played together," said the former Ypsilanti High School standout. "I thought we did well considering."

Vanvick agreed, adding that the team which best adjusted to the wind had the advantage.

"You'd think the game was lopsided score-wise, but it wasn't because of playing, but because of the wind," she said.

Lolucci, who played for Oberlin College, said she would have to continue her aggressiveness at the net if the pair hopes to beat Liz Batsole and Betsy Mehaffie. They will meet in the semifinals Saturday.

Last year, Wineberger and Attwood made it to the finals before succumbing to Jacki Koren and Sarah Okuyama.

Greden-Moran will face Mary Ellen Bruck and Sharon Sih in the semifinals.

Other pre-tournament favorites Linda Winslow and Val Twanmoh also were ousted in the quarterfinals. The pair was edged by Diane Cottrall and Debbie Crosby 3-6, 6-4, 6-4. Cottrall-Crosby will next face Cecilia Fileti and Sally Del ange
