Old play better than the young

Kathy VanDeWege outlasts Krissy Hentschel in the Ann Arbor City Closed Adult Tennis Tournament.

With only eight competitors in the top women's division of the Ann Arbor City Closed Adult Tennis Tournament, the road to the title isn't long.

Each of Saturday's competitors knew that three victories would win the championship.

Kathy VanDeWege, the No. 1 seed, was definitely aware of that Saturday when she outlasted Krissy Hentschel 4-6, 6-3, 6-2 at Pioneer High School to earn a berth in next weekend's semifinals.

VanDeWege's victory was the only one of the day's three matches in the women's AA division that went three sets.

"I guess I picked a good tournament," VanDeWege said. "I don't have to win a lot of matches. Even though there's only eight women, I think there's a lot of us that could win it.'

VanDeWege, who played tennis at U-M from 1976-80, had experience, but not youth on her side against Hentschel, a 1991 Huron High graduate.

'It was real close," VanDeWege said. "Either one of us could've pulled it out. I think she's bigger and stronger and she certainly hits the ball harder. I was just fortunate to hit a few more balls over the net than she was.'

VanDeWege, who has never played singles in the Ann Arbor tournament, will play the winner of Thursday's match between Beth Pierce and Kristi King at Burns Park on Saturday. In the other semifinal, Betsy Mehaffie will play Ami Walsh, the No. 2 seed and last vear's runner-up.

DEFENDING CHAMPS: Men's

defending champions Paul Ripley (AA singles) and Mike Blinder (B singles) each won. Claude Wilcox (40 and over) wasn't so fortunate. He lost in the quarterfinals to Jonathan Trobe 7-6 (7-5), 6-2. Kirk Granlund, who won last year's A singles, wasn't entered, but No. 1 seed Rod Beer is undefeated.

Alice Britt, the runner-up last rear in B singles, lived up to her billing as the No. 1 seed after defending champion Linda Woodland didn't enter. Forty and over defending champion Emily Bowen won her only match as the No. 1 seed.

NAME GAME: Ademola Osofisan and Ojumayowa Alabi, both from Nigeria, won their opening

Osofisan, who won both matches in men's A singles, said his first name means "I should win my next match." According to Alabi, however, Osofisan's name has a meaning closer to "God's grace is the highest."

Alabi, who played in men's B singles, said his name means "God bring joy.'

MARATHON MATCH: Ernie Perich and Carey Colbertson have played against each other about 10 times within the past year in the Liberty Men's League. But Saturday's B singles quarterfinal will probably be the most memorable.

It lasted three hours and 30 minutes before Perich aced Colbertson to win 3-6, 7-6 (7-5), 6-4.
